

# ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE (ENL)

## **ENL 600 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)**

### *Arts & Sciences*

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester.  
Repeatable

## **ENL 610 Oral Communication in Teaching (0 Credits)**

### *Arts & Sciences*

Language, culture, and teaching strategies needed to communicate effectively in academic situations for international teaching assistants.  
Repeatable

## **ENL 615 Enhancing Listening, Speaking and Presentation Skills in English (0 Credits)**

### *Arts & Sciences*

Develops oral communication and pronunciation for academic and non-academic settings. The work includes activities to enhance listening, speaking, and presentation skills regarding cultural and field-specific topics, while developing effective teamwork strategies.

## **ENL 620 Advanced Oral Communication in Training (0 Credits)**

### *Arts & Sciences*

Continuing course in language, culture, and teaching strategies needed for effective communication in academic and social situations. For international teaching assistants.

Advisory recommendation Prereq: ENL 207 or ENL 610

## **ENL 640 Conversation for International Teaching Assistants (0 Credits)**

### *Arts & Sciences*

## **ENL 650 Graduate Writing for Multilingual Speakers of English (3 Credits)**

### *Arts & Sciences*

This is a writing course for graduate students whose primary language is not English. Students learn to analyze and produce genres in their disciplines, develop documents for job searches, improve writing cohesiveness and clarity, refine academic language, and use strategies to enhance writing.
