## Minor Admission

With the permission of their home school or college, students may pursue an 18-credit program leading to a minor in architecture. Admission into the Architecture minor requires students be in good academic standing with a 2.0 GPA or higher. Successful completion of the minor requires a 2.0 GPA in the 18 credits. To enroll in the Architecture minor, students must meet with the Minor Coordinator to discuss an academic plan.

## Minor Requirements

The Architecture Minor requires 18 credit hours. 6 credit hours (2 courses) must be introductory architecture courses, 6 credit hours (2 classes) of architectural drawing and design, and 6 credit hours (2 classes) in upper-division architecture electives from the list below.
