ESP 200 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)

Maxwell

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester. Repeatable 1 times for 6 credits maximum

ESP 280 International Course (1-12 Credits)

Maxwell

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the S.U. academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

ESP 300 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)

Maxwell

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester. Repeatable 1 times for 6 credits maximum

ESP 380 International Course (1-12 Credits)

Maxwell

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the S.U. academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

ESP 400 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)

Maxwell

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester. Repeatable 6 times for 6 credits maximum

ESP 410 Environment, Sustainability and Policy Capstone Seminar (3 Credits)

Maxwell

Capstone seminar for the Environment, Sustainability, and Policy major. Students will investigate a sustainability-related topic employing perspectives from the natural sciences, social sciences, and humanities. Topic announced each time offered.

Prereq: (ECN 101 or ENG 140 or GEO 103 or WRT 115) AND (EAR 105 or EAR 203 or BIO 123 or GEO 155 or GEO 215)

ESP 415 Climate and the Humanities (3 Credits)

Maxwell

Explore climate change through humanities perspectives. Examine history, meaning, emotion, and politics related to global warming. Engage with topics such as environmental dystopias and utopias, climate fiction and literary nonfiction, and creative responses to the Anthropocene. Foster critical thinking skills about climate change.

ESP 470 Experience Credit (1-6 Credits)

Maxwell

Participation in a discipline or subject related experience. Student must be evaluated by written or oral reports or an examination. Permission in advance with the consent of the department chairperson, instructor, and dean. Limited to those in good academic standing.

Repeatable 6 times for 6 credits maximum

ESP 480 International Course (1-12 Credits)

Maxwell

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the S.U. academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

Repeatable

ESP 490 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)

Maxwell

Exploration of a problem, or problems, in depth. Individual independent study upon a plan submitted by the student. Admission by consent of supervising instructor(s) and the department.

ESP 499 Honors Thesis (1-6 Credits)

Maxwell

Repeatable 6 times for 6 credits maximum
