GREEK (GRE)

GRE 101 Ancient Greek I (4 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Introductory course which prepares students to acquire a reading knowledge of Classical Attic Greek, focusing on morphology and syntax, and its role in the culture and literature of ancient Greek society. No prior experience or admission by placement testing. Students cannot enroll in GRE 101 after earning credit for GRE 102, GRE 201, GRE 202, or higher. Prereg: Required Placement Exam Score

GRE 102 Ancient Greek II (4 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Continuing course with emphasis on morphology and syntax. Introduction to examples of unsimplified Ancient Greek prose of the classical period, read and interpreted within the cultural context of ancient Greek society. Students cannot enroll in GRE 102 after earning credit for GRE 201, GRE 202, or higher.

GRE 180 International Course (1-12 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the SU academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

GRE 200 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester. Repeatable

GRE 201 Ancient Greek III (4 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Continuing course with review of morphology and syntax and further study of idioms, rhetorical figures, and syntactic peculiarities. Reading and study of representative prose authors. Students cannot enroll in GRE 201 after earning credit for a course higher than GRE 201.

GRE 280 International Course (1-12 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the S.U. academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

GRE 290 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)

Exploration of a problem, or problems, in depth. Individual independent study upon a plan submitted by the student. Admission by consent of supervising instructor(s) and the department.

GRE 300 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester. Repeatable

GRE 310 Greek Prose Authors (3 Credits)

Readings from selected ancient Greek prose authors. Review of grammar and syntax.

Prereq: GRE 102

GRE 320 Greek Poetry (3 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Readings from selected ancient Greek poets. Review of grammar and syntax. Greek metrics and prosody.

GRE 380 International Course (1-12 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the S.U. academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

GRE 410 Advanced Greek Prose (3 Credits)

Readings from selected Greek prose authors. Repeatable 4 times for 12 credits maximum Prereg: GRE 310

GRE 420 Advanced Greek Poetry (3 Credits)

Readings from selected Greek poets. Repeatable 4 times for 12 credits maximum Prereq: GRE 310

GRE 490 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)

Exploration of a problem, or problems, in depth. Individual independent study upon a plan submitted by the student. Admission by consent of supervising instructor(s) and the department.
