## **HNR 200 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)**

### *Arts & Sciences*

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester.

## **HNR 210 Arts in Society Seminar (1 Credit)**

### *Arts & Sciences*

Experience-based introduction to the arts in the city of Syracuse, such as opera, symphony, stage, and visual art.
