

LATIN (LAT)

LAT 101 Latin I (4 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Introductory course which prepares students to acquire a reading knowledge of classical Latin, focusing on morphology and syntax, and its role in the culture and literature of ancient Roman society. Students cannot enroll in LAT 101 after earning credit for LAT 102, LAT 201, LAT 202, or higher.

Prereq: Required Placement Exam Score

LAT 102 Latin II (4 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Continuing course with emphasis on morphology and syntax. Introduction to examples of unsimplified Latin prose of the Republic and Empire, read and interpreted within the cultural context of Greco-Roman society. Students cannot enroll in LAT 102 after earning credit for LAT 201, LAT 202, or higher.

Prereq: LAT 101 OR REQUIRED PLACEMENT EXAM SCORE

LAT 104 Beginning Latin IV (3 Credits)

LAT 180 International Course (1-12 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the SU academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

Repeatable

LAT 201 Latin III (4 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Continuing course with review of morphology and syntax and further study of idioms, rhetorical figures, and syntactic peculiarities. Reading and study of representative prose authors. Students cannot enroll in LAT 201 after earning credit for a course higher than LAT 201.

Prereq: LAT 102 OR REQUIRED PLACEMENT EXAM SCORE

LAT 280 International Course (1-12 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the S.U. academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

LAT 290 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Exploration of a problem, or problems, in depth. Individual independent study upon a plan submitted by the student. Admission by consent of supervising instructor(s) and the department.

LAT 310 Latin Prose Authors (3 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Readings from selected authors. Review of grammar and syntax.

Prereq: LAT 201 OR REQUIRED PLACEMENT EXAM SCORE

Readings from selected Latin poets. Review of grammar and syntax.

Latin metrics and prosody.

LAT 390 Independent Study (3 Credits)

LAT 410 Advanced Latin Prose (3 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Readings from selected Latin prose authors.

Repeatable 4 times for 12 credits maximum

Prereq: LAT 310

LAT 420 Advanced Latin Poetry (3 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Readings from selected Latin poets.

Repeatable 4 times for 12 credits maximum

Prereq: LAT 320

LAT 490 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Exploration of a problem, or problems, in depth. Individual independent study upon a plan submitted by the student. Admission by consent of supervising instructor(s) and the department.

Repeatable

LAT 500 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester.
