LLA 200 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester.

LLA 201 Elements of Law (3 Credits)

Arts & Sciences

Provides an introduction to law and legal institutions. The course is designed to prepare lower-division undergraduates for the further study of legal topics in departments across the College of Arts and Sciences.

SUAbroad works with the S.U. academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.
