SOS 200 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)*Maxwell*

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester.

SOS 280 International Course (1-6 Credits)*Maxwell*

Offered through SUAbroad by educational institution outside the United States. Student registers for the course at the foreign institution and is graded according to that institution's practice. SUAbroad works with the S.U. academic department to assign the appropriate course level, title, and grade for the student's transcript.

SOS 390 Independent Study (1-12 Credits)*Maxwell*

Exploration of a problem, or problems, in depth. Individual independent study upon a plan submitted by the student. Admission by consent of supervising instructor(s) and the department.

SOS 400 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)*Maxwell*

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester.

SOS 470 Experience Credit (1-2 Credits)*Maxwell*

Participation in a discipline or subject related experience. Student must be evaluated by written or oral reports or an examination. Permission in advance with the consent of the department chairperson, instructor, and dean. Limited to those in good academic standing.

SOS 490 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)*Maxwell*

Exploration of a problem, or problems, in depth. Individual independent study upon a plan submitted by the student. Admission by consent of supervising instructor(s) and the department.

SOS 500 Selected Topics (1-6 Credits)*Maxwell*

Exploration of a topic (to be determined) not covered by the standard curriculum but of interest to faculty and students in a particular semester.

SOS 575 Philosophy of Social Science (3 Credits)*Maxwell*

Cross-listed with PHI 575

Philosophical and methodological issues in social and behavioral science. Role of laws in explanation of human action, methodological individualism and holism, functional explanation, value-neutrality, behaviorism, and computer simulation.

SOS 590 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)*Maxwell*

Exploration of a problem, or problems, in depth. Individual independent study upon a plan submitted by the student. Admission by consent of supervising instructor(s) and the department.
